



EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING AWARD

The Manitoba Association of Home Economists is the professional association representing professionals who have graduated in Home Economics/Human Ecology. Members actively promote an improved quality of life for individuals and families in Manitoba related to diverse professional practice areas in nutrition/foods, textiles/clothing and family studies, through encouraging the highest standards of excellence in service to the public. The Association aims to encourage and support students at undergraduate and graduate levels. The Association is responsible for establishing and maintaining standards associated with the profession, with qualified members having professional status, as governed by the Act.

Criteria:

The Excellence in Teaching Award is bestowed annually to a teaching member of the Faculty of Human Ecology, or the Faculty of Education (home economics/human ecology), University of Manitoba, to honour an individual who has displayed a high quality of teaching ability, which includes communication, integrity, scholarship, leadership, experience, and service to the community to enhance the quality and standards of education for her/his students.

Teaching:

- Effective transmission of knowledge through course work and related activities
- Sustained respect of students
- Leadership in the introduction of innovative methods of teaching
- Development of courses and programs in new areas of importance to the Faculty

Service:

- Executive, board or committee positions in the local, provincial, national or international professional association
- Distinguished service in community organizations, task forces, and committees

The award consists of the recipient's name being engraved on the plaque, which has been placed in the main hallway of the Faculty of Human Ecology Building. On behalf of students, the recipient is presented with a plaque for her/his contribution at the Ringing Ceremony.

Nominations:

May be made by fourth year and graduate students enrolled in the Faculty of Human Ecology. Will be made in written form, providing some description of the nominee's teaching abilities in relation to the criteria. All information will be held confidential. Nominations will be sent to:
